

Conway Kenya Missions


Hollye and Larry Conway moved to Kenya 35 years ago. To say that they love the people of Kenya is an understatement.

They have been working with the street children in Nairobi for 16 years. Larry and Hollye work with "Truth, Reconciliation and Unity" (TRU). Their goal is to show and teach the street children in Nairobi the love of Christ. The children that are willing to turn away from drugs and life on the streets are provided with an education and job training skills. A day with TRU looks like this: The TRU team begins with a visit to the boys in the street. They open Gods



word and share His message with them. Today the message was from Matthew 13tells them about Jesus told about

hidden treasure, the pearl of great price. Almost daily the street children pick up a sack and go out looking for something that can be resold for a few shillings. With this in mind, the parables of the hidden treasure and pearl of great price really resonates with them. They know what it is like to go out and search for something of great value. After praying and sharing the lesson, Larry and his team bought a meal of beans and tortillas for the boys at a local small cafe. The TRU




team also organizes weekly soccer games with these boys. They spend time praying about their needs and sharing Gods word. The TRU team conducts an art class weekly for the boys. They utilize the art class to bring a pertinent a message from God's word. They ask each child to share the message they hear with one more person. They break into small groups to discuss how they shared last weeks lesson and take prayer request from one another.

Larry teaches at the Nairobi Great Commission School. He teaches classes on leadership, church ministry, and church planning. Students attend this school to gain leadership and ministry skills in a two year study program. Larry has students from Kenya, Uganda and Southern Sudan.

Larry utilizes his experience and doctoral studies to teach others about leadership and discipleship training. He shares how he organized and planted churches in Eldoret and Nairobi.



Hollye and Larry have helped to start a new mission off in Tanzania. Larry is very excited that this mission is funded by the Churches of Christ in Kenya. Larry has trained these churches to set up mission committee teams and talked with many churches about the support of Kenyan missionaries in
