# Summer 2023 Quarter Classes

## Sunday Morning (MAY-JUNE-JULY)

**Title: God First—Pursuing God above All Else and Finding the Full Life in His Presence**

**Teacher: Daniel Brooks (138R)**

God created us to become like Jesus, experiencing deep relationship with Him. In this world, our hearts often become consumed with other priorities – some like family, work, and church that aren't bad in and of themselves. These pursuits alone, however, can never fulfill us and may in fact distract from the one thing that can – experiencing God's Presence every day. In this class, we'll use short lessons followed by small group discussions to help us: (1) renew our passion for God and set Him as our top priority; (2) develop disciplines through which we seek and experience Him; (3) consider how to allow Him total control of our hearts; and (4) establish mentoring relationships through which we can learn from others who are pursuing God as first priority.

**Title: Hardin Valley church of Christ: An Introduction and Bible Basics**

“Hardin Valley Church of Christ: An Introduction” is a 3-4 week overview of Hardin Valley church of Christ background, beliefs, structure and ministry. The rest of the quarter will be devoted to an overview of Bible basics. Depending on where you are in your faith journey, this can be a great first look or refresher. In addition to a basic overview of Hardin Valley church of Christ, worship, membership, small groups, and our vision for Hardin Valley, the class will feature a personalized spiritual gifts survey and ministry involvement opportunities. If you are new to Hardin Valley, or if you've been here awhile and just want to find out how to get more involved—this is the class for you!

**Title: Growing Greater (Ladies Class)**

Abundant faith; Love for each other; Perseverance; Endurance; Faith even in affliction.... Who wouldn't want to be described this way? These phrases described the Church in Thessalonica—but they also describe the Church in Hardin Valley! **Come learn from women in all stages of life who**

are daily growing their faith and living out II Thes 1:3-4. We'll also explore practical ways we can each be “considered worthy of the kingdom of God.”

**Title: Seeking Udenominational Christianity**

The concept of unity between all believers reached a defining point in what has historically been referred to as the Restoration Movement. These restorationists were concerned about “denominational names and creeds” and decided to seek to be called just Christians, thus becoming a more unified church. At the Hardin Valley Church, we have our roots in this restoration movement and its emphasis on Christian unity.

Two centuries plus have passed since the restoration movement began with its emphasis on Christian unity. Denominational names and practices have developed in the movement as well as many schisms, divisions, and sectarian attitudes. Is it possible for us today to return to our roots and seek unity with all believers by being udenominational in character and non-sectarian in attitude?

This class will review the scripture's teaching on unity and explore how we can seek to be udenominational and non-sectarian in our attitudes and practices. We will review and learn from the history of the restoration movement and its good and not so good examples. This study will help us understand who we are today, how we got that way, and, perhaps more importantly, where we need to go from here.

**Title: That the World May Know**

Using Ray Vander Laan's video series “That the World May Know“, we will discover how the events of Jesus' day impacted His life, ministry, and teachings.
