Severe & Hazardous Weather Guidelines

In the event of hazardous weather in the Knoxville area, members are encouraged to use their personal judgment regarding participation in activities at the church building, including worship services.

Unless a cancellation of services or activities is announced via email, our website homepage (hvcoc.org), social media, or on local television at least one-hour prior to the scheduled starting time, events will proceed as scheduled. Having said that, members should not feel they must be in attendance if they have a worship assignment (i.e., prayer, communion, teaching, etc.) if they are not comfortable exposing themselves or their families to the elements.

Regarding Sunday morning worship, the typical plan will be to offer a live streaming service beginning at the normal appointed time of 8:45am. You will be able to access this live service through the normal options. Should the streaming service not be available, members are encouraged to conduct their own personal devotional service in their home.

In the event that a Sunday worship should be canceled, a decision will be made at the time of cancellation regarding rescheduling the service for later in that day should conditions be expected to improve.
